Learning Outcomes

- To review the elements of the patient discharge process, through mapping: to enable any gaps and overlaps to be reconsidered in the context of policy/best practice and the evidence base.
- To explore the antecedents, critical attributes and consequences for patient risk assessment, through examination of the pertinent literature: to demonstrate useful tools for this purpose in the process of patient discharge from hospital.
- To engender a patient centred discharge process through discussion of current research findings: to stimulate new ideas and approaches to an age-old problem.
- To analyse factors of safety, barriers /facilitators, readmissions and process for patient selection for discharge (criteria-led discharge) through group work: to enable core considerations in establishing a process.

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This Master Class will examine the elements of safe, effective patient discharge from hospital. The evidence base together with practical tools and suggestions will form the framework for the day.

This master class will benefit delegates by providing the opportunity to revisit the discharge process within your organisation with a view to stimulating new and innovative approaches for effective patient discharge. The evidence base and practical tools to take away, will underpin the topics of risk, safety and patient centeredness.

It begins by providing an overview of national UK discharge policies/best practice guidance and encourages delegates to highlight the significance of these to their practice.

Delegates will be able to explore a deep understanding of risk, patient assessment and patient centeredness for discharge, to critically evaluate how and why aspects from this should be considered in practice settings. Finally, criteria led discharge and its implementation will be described (with tools).

The day will be interspersed with plenty of opportunities for discussion in order to challenge issues, which are considered barriers to a smooth patient discharge process.

The masterclass is facilitated by **Liz Lees-Deutsch**. Liz has 30 years of expertise in acute and community nursing. Throughout her career she has maintained a strong research interest on the topic of patient discharge. Liz has authored 73 publications and is the sole Editor of two multi-author, multi-disciplinary books on discharge planning (2007, 2012). She has taught on the topic of patient-discharge in Australia, Canada, Singapore, Jersey, Dublin, Belfast and the Outer Hebrides.

In 2014, Liz was awarded a Clinical Doctoral Fellowship from the National Institute of Healthcare Research. She investigated 'how patients are assessed for discharge from acute care'. In 2016 she received a Life Fellowship from the Society for Acute Medicine for her contribution to multi-professional development.

During 2017, Liz undertook a systematic review of the evidence supporting Criteria Led Discharge evidence, with the NHSI and helped to facilitate national workshops. She recently commenced a Clinical Academic role where she teaches on the Clinical Academic Internship, Masters to Doctorate programme and is currently building a programme of post-doctoral research related to criteria led discharge, through a post doctoral fellowship with her colleagues at Birmingham University.

Her passion and enthusiasm for the topic of patient discharge and pragmatic approach, will inspire those who attend this master class.
