AMaT is a revolutionary tool that enables Trusts to manage and track their audit activity in real time, using an array of dashboards, which can be filtered by the user to drill into the audit data using filters such as specialty, guidance, and divisions. Additionally, it includes paper-free ward auditing, a facility to share audits between Trusts, monitoring of outcomes and actions, plus a facility for all clinicians to record their own audit activity and store certificates in a personal online portfolio.
