What we have now

- Primary Care
 - QOF
 - Depression 1: people on the diabetes and/or CHD registers to whom the Depression indicator relates
 - Depression 2: all patients on practice lists who have a current diagnosis of depression.
- (It is important to note that the Depression 2 indicator denominator is based only on a subset of this register, i.e. those who are recently diagnosed.)
- Social Care
 - Permeates Social Care returns – but not all in one place and at CSSR level only
- Surveys

 - MHMDS
 - IAPT
 - Use of the Mental Health Act
 - Guardianship
 - CAMHS – April 2013
 - Learning Disabilities – on the cards
- Also
 - Mental Capacity Act advocacy
 - Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards

Use of Mental Health Act

- KP90
 - Due later in October
 - Some reworking from input of experts
 - Reducing data collection burden - consultation
- MHMDS
 - From v4, can follow MHA changes
 - Proposal to change data source
- Quarterly analysis
 - Rate of detention on admission by provider (from Q1)

New from v4

- Where to start?
- Tabular structure
 - 10 tables removed
 - 9 new tables
 - Psychosis details (previously recorded on FERN)
 - Referral details
 - Delayed Discharges (Unify2)
 - Crisis Plan
 - HoNOS variants and PHQ9
 - Home Leave
 - Self Harm (Count Me In)
 - Restraint (Count Me In)
 - Seclusion (Count Me In)

Reconfigured tables

- Disaggregated from Review table
 - Employment
 - Accommodation
 - Primary and secondary diagnoses
 - HoNOS
 - Intervention (not mandated)
 - CPA Episode
- Staff table
 - Replaces KWS and RC
- Team Episode
 - Replaces CEP and PGEP
- Hospital Provider Spell and Inpatient Episode
 - Replace IPEP
- Healthcare Professional Contact
 - Replaces OPATT, KWCONT, CCONT and PGCONT
